Cryotherapy treatment

Cryotherapy, also known as Cryosurgery, is a well-established and highly successful treatment option for many benign skin lesions. It is non-invasive with minimal discomfort.

The process involves using extremely cold liquid Nitrous Oxide at minus 84° Centigrade. This causes a "cold burn" to the lesion.

This technique is more effective than commercially available over-the-counter cold and freeze treatments.

Cryotherapy can be used to treat

Warts and Verrucas

Actinic keratosis (sun damaged skin lesions)

Superficial Basal Cell Carcinoma (a type of skin cancer which is extremely slow growing and can safely be treated using this technique)

Seborrhoeic keratosis

Skin tags
